MEETING DATE: September 19, 2019

SUBJECT: Authorize the HPUD Board President to sign a letter to LAFCO approving a temporary water service connection for construction of Border Wall Projected located outside of the District's Service Area.

ISSUE: Shall the Heber PUD Board authorize the President to sign a letter to LAFCO approving a temporary water service connection for construction of Border Wall Projected located outside of the District's Service Area?

GENERAL MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION:

Approve.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Possible Water Fund Revenue from Temporary Fire Hydrant Meter.

At this time, we anticipate about \$50,000 over a 3-4 month period.

BACKGROUND:

Staff was approached by Barnard Company who has been contracted to build the border wall outside of the HPUD Service Area. Barnard was looking at several options for water delivery including constructing wells in the desert. However, this option was not meeting the timeline that they need to meet and they want to start the project with water from HPUD and finish using well water.

The HPUD has the water available to sell, but in order for HPUD to provide water to anyone outside of our service area, we need approval from LAFCO. The construction company, Barnard, submitted an application with LAFCO and we received the attached documents from LAFCO.

In order to start providing water in large volumes using two hydrants and four meter, the HPUD must submit a letter stating that:

- 1) The HPUD approves the extension of water service.
- 2) The HPUD understands and confirms that the authorization by LAFCO is for a temporary extension of water.

CONCLUSION:

Staff recommends that the Board authorize the HPUD Board President to sign a letter to LAFCO approving a temporary water service connection for construction of Border Wall Projected located outside of the District's Service Area.

WHEREAS, the extension of water service is outside of the Heber Public Utility Districts service area; and

WHEREAS, the applicant will obtain water via water trucks; and

WHEREAS, the Heber Public Utility District approved the extension of water service for the proposed project; and


WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has been delegated the authority by the Commission to review and approve this type of project

- b) The extension of water service is limited to the proposed project and the applicant will obtain water via water trucks.
- c) The applicant/district shall provide to LAFCO the following items in order to complete the processing of the extension.
 1. Letter from Applicant/District to confirm that the applicant/district understands that the authorization by LAFCO is for a temporary extension of water.
 2. Letter from the District approving the extension of water.

INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

As part of this application, applicant and real party in interest, if different, agree to defend, indemnify, hold harmless, and release the Imperial County Local Agency Formation Commission, its agents, officers, attorneys, and employees (including consultants) from any claim, action, or proceeding brought against any of them, the purpose of which is to attack, set aside, void, or annul the approval of this application or adoption of the environmental document which accompanies it. This indemnification obligation shall include, but not be limited to, damages, costs, expenses, attorney fees, or expert witness fees that may be asserted by any person or entity, including the applicant, arising out of or in connection with the approval of this application, whether or not there is concurrent negligence on the part of the Imperial County Local Agency Formation Commission, its agents, officers, attorneys, or employees (including consultants).

If any claim, action, or proceeding is brought against Imperial County Local Agency Formation Commission, its agents, officers, attorneys, or employees, to attack, set aside, void, or annul the approval of the application or adoption of the environmental document which accompanies it, then the following procedures shall apply:

1. The Executive Officer shall promptly notify the Commission of any claim, action or proceeding brought by an applicant challenging the Commission's action. The Commission, its agents, attorneys and employees (including consultants) shall fully cooperate in the defense of that action.
2. The Commission shall have final determination on how to best defend the case and may defend it with in-house counsel, or by retaining outside counsel. In either case applicant shall be fully responsible for all costs incurred. Applicant may request to provide his or her own counsel to defend the case, however prior written approval of the Commission shall be obtained. Said independent counsel shall work with LAFCO counsel to provide a joint defense and shall include a complete defense of LAFCO to the satisfaction of the Commission.


