Subject: January 2016 Monthly Report

On the billing cycle ending on the 24<sup>th</sup> of January 26,070,000 million gallons of water were used by our consumers, an average of 815,000 thousand gallons was used per day.

On January 12, 2016 collected the first quarter TTHM's and Haa5 samples and were sent to E.S. Babcock Laboratory for analysis. The results came in on February 1, 2016 and were above the maximum contaminant levels (MCL) for the Haa5. The running annual average (RAA) MCL for Haa5 is 60 parts per billion (ppb) and for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2016 we attained a RAA of 67 ppb for first site and 72 ppb on the second site. Heber Public Utility District is out of Compliance and will be mailing out public notice on these violations.

HPUD is currently working with State Water Board the Division of Drinking Water and our Engineers, the Holt Group in order to find a viable solution to be included in the upcoming Water Treatment expansion project to reduce the Haa5 below the MCL.






