Subject: January 2020 Monthly Report

On the billing cycle ending on the 21st of January 13,320,000 million gallons of water were used by our consumers, an average of 444,000 thousand gallons was used per day.

On January 24, 2020, collected the 1st quarter Trihalomethanes (TTHM's) and Haloacetic Acids (Haa5) samples and were sent to Clinical Lab of San Bernardino for analysis. The results came in on February 4, 2020 and were once again below the maximum contaminant levels (MCL) for TTHM's. The running annual average (RAA) MCL for TTHM's is 80 parts per billion (ppb) and we attained 52 ppb for the Mc Cabe site and 44 ppb for the Little Field site. Heber Public Utility District continues to be in compliance with the State and Federal Water Regulations.




