SUBJECT: Consider Waiving the No Alcohol in the Park Ordinance for a One Day Event on October 29, 2016.

ISSUE: Shall the Board allow the sale and consumption of alcohol at Tito Huerta Park on October 29, 2016 for the Parade, Car Show, 5K Run planned for the HPUD 85th Anniversary Celebration?

GENERAL MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Board waive the No Alcohol in the Park Ordinance 220 for a one day event to celebrate the 85th Anniversary of HPUD on October 29, 2016.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The insurance for this event will be slightly higher if alcohol is allowed. Disposition of the proceeds from sales will be determined by the 85th Anniversary committee and brought back to this Board in September.

DISCUSSION:

As part of the 85th Anniversary Celebration, staff is recommending that the Board allow for the sale of alcohol at Tito Huerta Park during the events scheduled on October 29, 2016. These events include a parade that will end at Tito Huerta Park. 5K run that will start and end at the Park. A Car Show on Palm Avenue just after the parade. Food vendors and carnival activities to be held at the park all day.

CONCLUSION:

As this is an event sponsored by the HPUD, it is up to this Board to determine if you will allow for the sale and consumption of alcohol at the park. If not, the party will continue. If yes, then the sale will be regulated by the Alcohol Beverage Commission (ABC) and will follow all of the requirements of license from ABC, which includes approval from HPUD, Fire Department, and the Sheriff's Department.

ALTERNATIVE:

- 1) Do not allow for the sale and consumption of alcohol in Tito Park during the 85th Anniversary events on October 29th.
- 2) Provide alternative direction to staff.
