SUBJECT: Information Only Exceedance of HAA5 Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) at Water Treatment Plant.

INFORMATION ONLY:

As previously reported to the Board, the HPUD received a Citation for Violation of our HAA5 MCL. Today, May 16th, we received the results for the second quarter 2016 HAA5 and TTHM results.

The HAA5 results were low and we are now in compliance with the Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) at the McCabe Cove test site. However, we did not meet the MCL at the Littlefield test site. As required, the HPUD will issue a public notice to our customers in the June utility bill letting them know that we exceeded the HAA5 MCL this quarter at one of our testing sites.

We also received our TTHM lab results, and we are in compliance with the TTHM Maximum Contaminant Level for this quarter. Our TTHM numbers were high due to the high water temperature.

I will also be working on the Consumer Confidence Report that we must publish by the end of June.
