GENERAL MANAGER RECOMMENDATION:

Waive Ordinance 222 for the one-day event, Tamale Festival, on January 29, 2022.

DISCUSSION:

The Tamale Festival is back for 2022. The Molina's have submitted a park reservation and plans for the 2022 Tamale Festival to be held on Saturday, January 29, 2022 in Tito Huerta Park. Part of the festivities will include the sale of alcohol during the event. HPUD has adopted Ordinance 222 that prohibits the sale and consumption of alcohol in Tito Huerta Park. In order for the Tamale Festival to have alcohol sold and consumed during the Festival, the HPUD Board must waive Ordinance 222 for a one-day event to be held on Saturday, January 29, 2022.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that HPUD Board waive Ordinance 222 to allow the sale of alcohol on during the Tamale Festival on Saturday, January 29, 2022.
