**Status:**

The Heber Recreation Center Parking Lot Project and Recreation Patio were completed. USDA has notified HPUD of leftover funds to add to our Recreation Center. Additional funding will cover, storage unit, additional paving, fans and handwashing station.

The Office Manager is working with our IT consultant to buy the correct laptops that will meet the need. All the Rec Center laptops will have Microsoft Office for public use. We plan to have a Grand Re-Opening of our Rec Center once all projects are completed.

HPUD was awarded another community facilities grant for equipment for \$200,000.00. Staff collected quotes but need additional quotes to satisfy the USDA requirements for the grant.

**Status:**

Correll Park: the State of California has given us an extension agreement until 2028. We have filed a deed restriction with the State of California.
