The Heber Recreation Center Parking Lot Project was completed, HPUD staff has submitted invoices to USDA, HPUD has not yet received payment for the Parking Lot.

The Heber Recreation Center Patio has broken ground on March 8, 2023. The permits for the shade structure were secured with no issues. The project is set to be completed by the end of the month.

The Office Manager is working with our IT consultant to buy the correct laptops that will meet the need. All the Rec Center laptops will have Microsoft Office for public use. We plan to have a Grand Re-Opening of our Rec Center once all projects are completed.

HPUD was awarded another community facilities grant for \$200,000.00. This grant will go towards the purchase of vehicles and a lawn mower for our parks. Staff is working on getting quotes for the equipment that is needed.

Children's Park: HPUD Board of Directors awarded the Children's Park Project at the December 15, 2023 meeting. The Notice of Award has gone out to the contractor. The Holt Group is waiting for the insurance and bonds which will then be reviewed by General Counsel. The permits for this project have not been approved yet, pending plans for a parking lot that will meet ADA compliance requirements.

The General Manager and Office Manager had a preconstruction meeting with Three Peaks Corp. and The Holt Group to discuss the construction of the project. After a productive meeting, Three Peaks Corp. will be able to give us a construction start date after they acquire all the necessary parts for the project.

Correll Park: the State of California has given us an extension until 2028. We have filed a deed restriction with the State of California.
