GENERAL MANAGER'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the HPUD Board of Directors agree to allow Catholic Charities, Diocese of San Diego use of the HPUD Recreation Center for Congregate Meal Program.

FISCAL IMPACT:

DISCUSSION:

It has been brought to the General Manager's attention that the Congregate Meals, funded by the Imperial County Area Agency on Aging, administered by Catholic Charities, Diocese of San Diego at the Heber Community Center have ceased due to lack of staffing at the Heber Community Center.

The Heber Public Utility District would like to offer the HPUD Recreation Center to host the Congregate Meals. Catholic Charities is a nonprofit organization so their use of the Recreation Center would be at no cost to them. There is no current scheduling conflict.

Meals would start at once per week and increase frequency as participated grows.
