The Heber Recreation Center Parking Lot Project and Recreation Patio were completed. The change order allowed for a sidewalk to be added to the east side of the recreation center including a cement slab for a storage shed.

HPUD was awarded another community facilities grant for equipment for \$200,000.00. Staff have ordered most of the equipment on the grant and have received two new trucks for HPUD use. Once all of the equipment has been ordered we will submit it for reimbursement.
