Ordinance entitled as follows:

ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF IMPERIAL, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN THE UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY SITUATED WITHIN THE SAID COUNTY OF IMPERIAL DESCRIBED AS THE EAST HALF OF WEST HALF AND EAST HALF OF SECTION 28 AND WEST HALF OF THE WEST HALF OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 14 EAST, S. B. M., BEING FURTHER DESCRIBED AS THE LAND EMBRACED WITHIN THE ORIGINAL TOWNSHIP MAP OF THE TOWN OF HEBER IN THE SAID COUNTY OF IMPERIAL FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF SAID TERRITORY THE MATTER OF INCORPORATING A PUBLIC UTILITY DISTRICT WITHIN SUCH TERRITORY FIXING THE TIME OF SUCH ELECTION, ESTABLISHING THE ELECTION PRECINCTS, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES THEREIN AND THE NAMES OF THE ELECTION OFFICERS FOR EACH PRECINCT AND FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF SAID ELECTION OFFICERS.
